



Christmas in Santa Fe Sunrise Springs Resort Spa's Labyrinth of Light

After a delicious meal, guests are invited to return to the labyrinth for a wonderful cup of hot Mexican cocoa, under the winter stars. Known for its local, organic and natural cuisine, the Blue Heron Restaurant's seasonally inspired winter menu is complimented by views of the property's stunning winter landscape.
